## Why?

- Targeted intervention
- Onward transmission
- Reduce risk behaviours
- Decline unwanted sex / have the sex you want
- Correct condom use
- Establish HIV concordance
- Diagnose/treat STIs
- PEP
- Conceive children safely

- Criminalisation
- Safer Sex

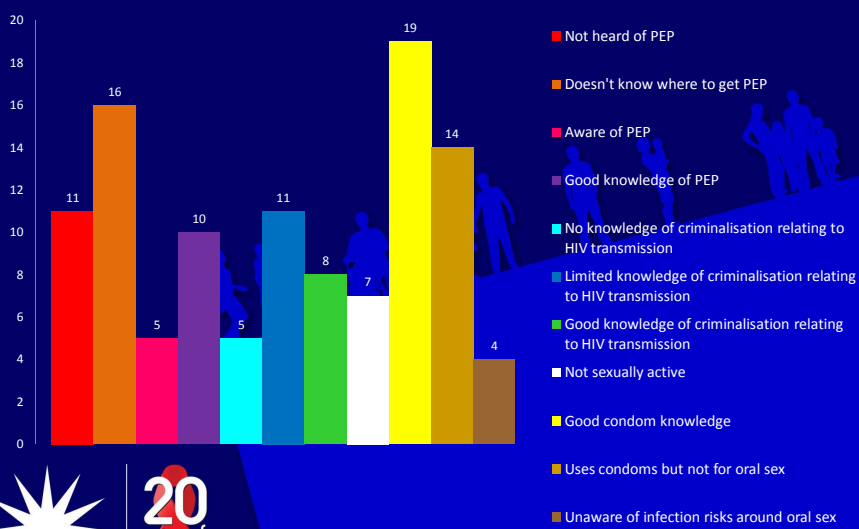


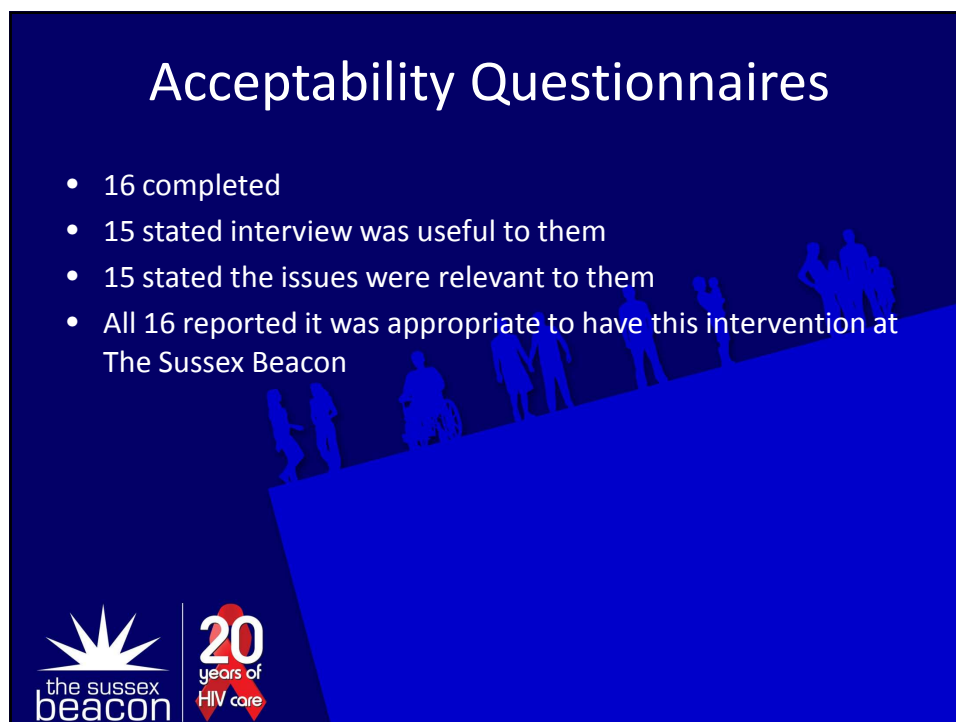
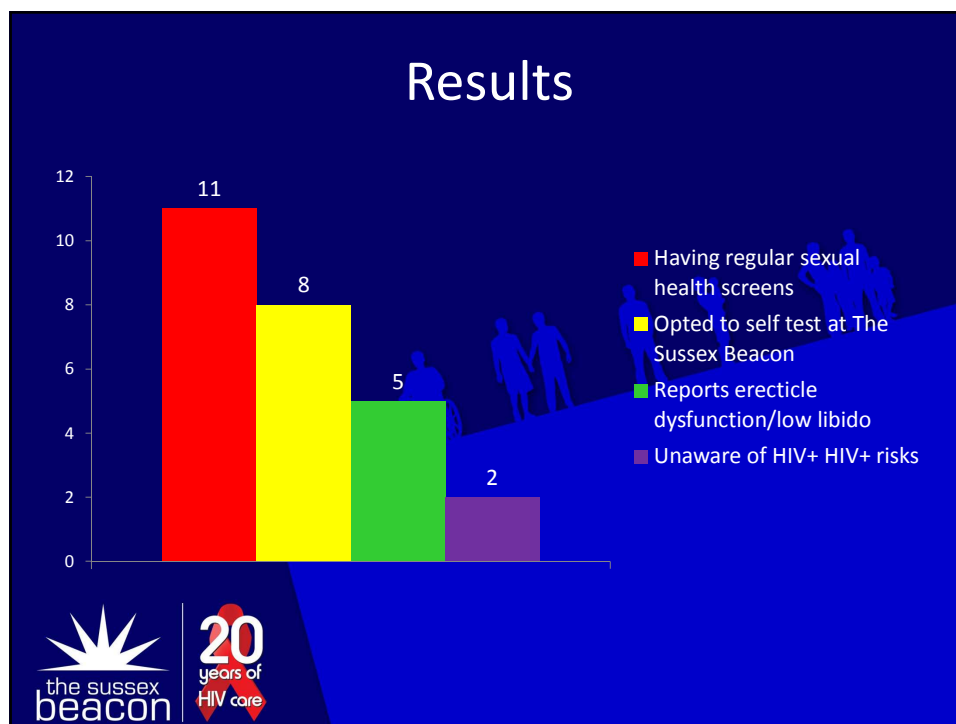
## Background

- Semi-structured interview
- Client acceptability questionnaire
- 25 interviews over 6 months on IPU
